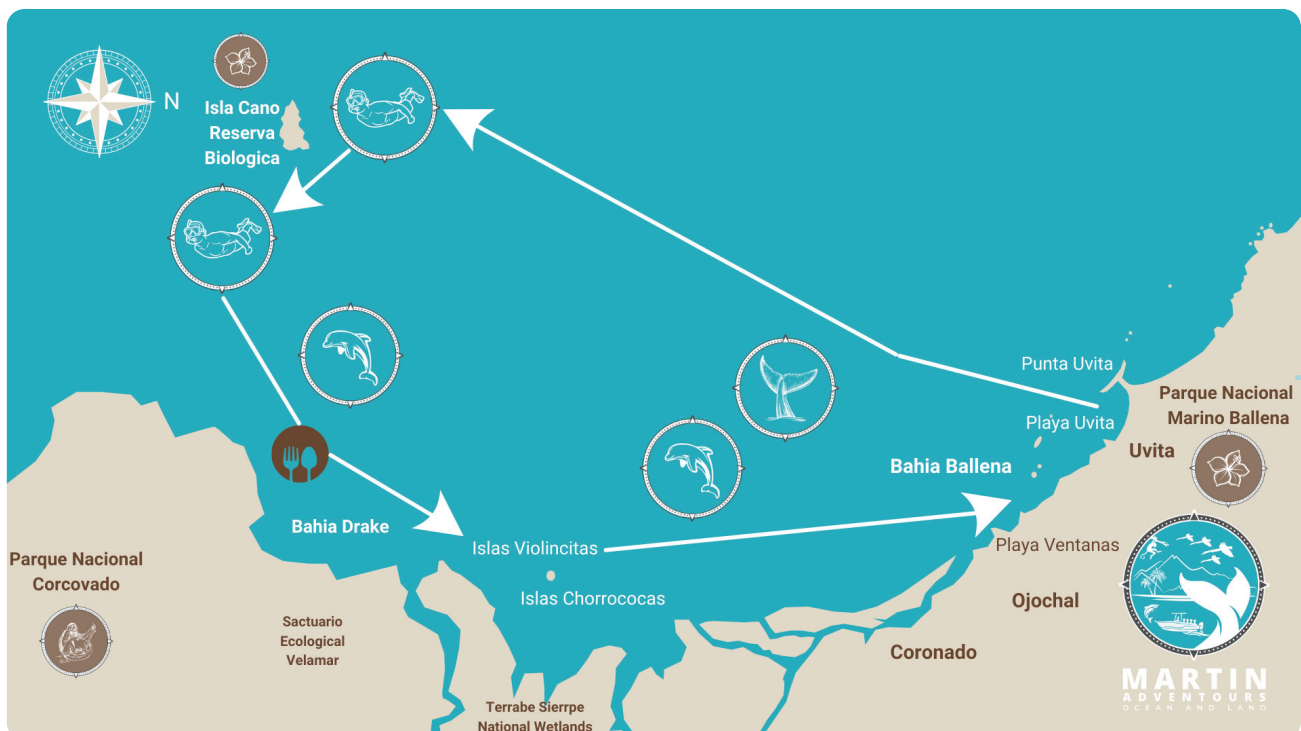

Expectations

Guests will check in at our property before walking to the main entrance of Marino Ballena National Park. Guests will arrive at our property for check-in and then walk to the main entrance of Parque Nacional Marina Ballena. From the park entrance, there is a short hike of approximately 15 minutes to the beach, where guests will board the tour boat from the beach.

Guests will arrive at our property for check-in, and then our guide will guide them to the parking place to leave your car at the main entrance of Parque Nacional Marina Ballena. From the park entrance, there is a short hike of approximately 5 minutes to the beach, where guests will board the tour boat from the beach. The tour boats will travel about 29 miles out to sea, arriving at Cano Island.
